As for the equipment inside, there are certain differences: the first level distribution cabinet generally has isolation switches, circuit breakers, leakage protectors, etc., the second level ...

Directly beneath and separate from the CUI designation indicator box, is the distribution statement in its entirety. Additional markings are included as required, e.g., export control.

At level 2, the yellow tag is used to signify the completion of component delivery, installation, and pre-startup activities. Once all Level 2 works are completed with the tag in place, ...

Primary Distribution Box: Serves as the main distribution box for a construction site or project (usually only one). Secondary Distribution Box: Serves each floor or building as needed. ...

Three level distribution refers to the general distribution box, distribution box, switch box. Two-level protection refers to the leakage protection of the main distribution box and switch box.

This device mainly protects the basic safety of the power system and provides a medium level of voltage limitation, but cannot fully protect sensitive equipment within the system.
