



Fangchang Bridge

With a total length of 6,409 m (21,027 ft) and a main span of 1,092 m (3,583 ft), it is the world's longest span high-speed railway bridge, tied with the Hutong Yangtze River Bridge.

Fangsheng Bridge is a historic stone arch bridge over the Cao Port in Zhujiajiao, Qingpu, Shanghai, China.

Fangsheng Bridge is a five-arch stone bridge--the largest, longest, and tallest five-arch stone bridge in the Shanghai area, earning it the title "No.1 Bridge in Shanghai."

Fangsheng bridge is located at the east end of North Street and crosses Caogang river. In 1571, it was built by the monk Xingchao of Cimen Temple in Zhujiajiao, after 15 years of funds raising.

Fangsheng Bridge (meaning Setting-fish-free Bridge) is the longest, largest and tallest stone bridge, in Zhujiajiao Ancient Town crossing Pearl Stream. Built in 1571 the bridge stands a stone tablet named ...

The Sino-Vietnamese Friendship Bridge connects them. While the bridge itself isn't particularly grand, given the river's narrowness, it was built in 1958 and is 111 meters long.

Originally known as Shuangfeng Bridge and later as Fangshun Bridge, it has been lovingly restored over the years, with its most significant renovation occurring in the mid-16th century.
