Urinary catheters are primarily measured by their diameter, which is indicated in French (Fr) units. One French unit corresponds to 1/3 of a millimeter, and the size of the catheter is essential for proper fit ...

Unlike the Birmingham gauge, where larger gauge numbers indicate smaller diameters, an increasing French size corresponds to a larger outer diameter. The French scale measures the outer diameter ...

"French" or "FR" is equivalent to 0.33 millimeters, which converts to .013 inch or 1/77 inch in diameter. French size does not apply to the length of the catheter.

In adults, the typical size of a Foley catheter is 14-16 French (Fr), with 16 Fr being the most commonly used standard size for routine catheterization. 1. Remember that while larger ...

Sizes range from 6-12 French for children and 14-22 French for adults. The funnel end of the catheter is often color coded to allow for easier size identification.

o 8 Fr - 10 Fr: Generally used for pediatric patients or adults with narrow urethral passages, these smaller sizes offer a gentler approach for delicate circumstances.
