

How to coil pigtail cable

Learn how to properly coil and organize electrical cables to maintain their longevity. Avoid twisting or fighting against the cable's natural coil to prevent fraying.

Start coiling the cable around the dowel, pushing it up toward the taped part of the cable, and keeping each coil tight using your thumb. You want to make sure that each coil is the same size ...

Want to coil a cable that won't get tangled when unraveled? Here's how!
