

# Jordan Openwork Bridge

Jordan 2NT or Truscott 2NT is a convention, used after a takeout double of a 1-major opening. When this convention is on, the following responses apply after 1<3/1? - (X): XX: strength-showing redouble, ...

Where partner opens a major (say S), and overcaller doubles, responder bids 2S with a minimum hand, 3S preemptively, and a Jordan 2NT as a limit raise or better. XX in this position shows 10+ points, ...

Jordan 2 Notrump (Jordan 2NT) - After partner opens and Right Hand Opponent Doubles, a 2 Notrump call by responder shows good trump support and a limit plus raise (10+ points).

Jordan 2NT (aka Truscott 2NT) is an artificial limit raise by responder. It's used when partner opens 1-major and the opponents make a takeout double.

RDBL in this position shows 10+ points, and tends to deny opener's suit, and says this is your hand. You can also use it after minor openings too. Found any errors or have a Convention to add?

The "Jordan 2-NT" Convention is an artificial convention utilizing a "2-NT" response to Partner's opening of one-of-a-suit (1C, 1D, 1H, or 1S). It shows a limit-Raise, 10-12 HCP's or better; i.e., 8-Losers or ...

Used as limit raise or better after opening partner 1<3/1? and then RHO double: 4+ card fit. Further the balance bid. ?? <3 ?.

Jordan 2NT shows a limit raise or better with 4+ trumps after partner's opener is doubled. Learn the structure, competing beyond game, and opener's rebids.

In our agreement, 1M- (X)-2NT shows 4+ card support. We use a different bid (not XX) to show a limit raise (or better) with exactly 3-card support. In our agreement, 1M- (X)-2NT shows 4+ ...
