The doors shall be keyed separately from other facility keys. Preferred method for keying communication room is badge access, limited to only IT personnel and related vendors.

Features: connected by four corner to ensure the stability; cable entry from the top cover and bottom panel; removable side doors for easy installation and maintenance.

Square hole mounting rails are adjustable front to rear. Rear doors are split "french style" to save aisle space. Grounding kit and baying hardware included. Levelers and heavy-duty casters are standard. ...
