

The switch s optical port keeps going up and down

The port on our core switch (HP A5500) that our Smoothwall box is connected to keeps going up and down. It will drop for 3 seconds then come back up but this can have prolonged impact ...

Since the port is going 10M I would guess there is a issue with the cable. Either some termination is loose or you have a bad cable. TDR tests can help with this.
