A changed fur texture on your cat's tail can indicate allergies or parasites. Learn how to help and what is important.

Before you bag it, make sure to liberally apply oil to the roots of the tail, including the bare skin underneath, from the dock to the end of the tail bone. Then work the oil into the braid itself.

Also called tail gland hyperplasia, stud tail refers to overactive glands on the top of the tail. These glands produce waxy excretions that result in hair loss and crusty lesions.
