A second international undersea telecommunications cable to Tonga, named the "Tonga Hawaiki Branch System" will be co-funded by Australia and New Zealand, under a USD\$32 million ...

It has cable landing points at Sopu, a suburb of Nuku'alofa in Tonga, and Suva, Fiji. The project was funded by Asian Development Bank and the World Bank.

Tonga Cable Limited (TCL) was formed to manage the subsea cable project and brought OSI in to consult and advise across multiple areas, from project planning to implementation and delivery.

Tonga Cable Limited was formed in November 2009, with approval of Government of Tonga, to build and manage a submarine fibre optic cable to connect Tonga to an international network service.

The Tonga-Fiji Submarine Cable System is owned and operated by the state-owned Tonga Cable Limited (TCL), which was set up in 2011 to develop, and manage the submarine cable with financing ...

Tonga Cable System is a submarine fiber-optic cable system connecting Tonga with Fiji, where it connects to other international networks. It is 827 kilometres (514 mi) long and was activated in 2013. It has cable landing points at Sopu, a suburb of Nuku'alofa in Tonga, and Suva, Fiji. The project was funded by Asian Development Bank and the World Bank. An extension of the cable to Ha'apai and Vava'u was commissioned in April 2018.
